## FEE BREAKDOWN

### ANNUAL TUITION FEE

The Annual Tuition Fee covers the cost of the program, including:

- subject and assessment fees, resource levy to cover IBDP curriculum related items inclusive of textbooks, digital resources, use of school technology, internet and printing facilities, student ID cards, class incursions and excursion.

The Annual Tuition Fee does not cover the costs of:

- digital devices, graphic calculators, stationery items, replacement student ID cards, overnight school trips, optional excursions/school activities that are not part of the IBDP course of study or curriculum.

Parents/guardians are notified of these costs via ManageBac or by email, and these costs are charged separately to fee accounts.

If the Annual Building Fund Levy is paid in full prior to due date, a 3% discount is applied to the Annual Tuition Fee. The fee is therefore reduced to **\$14,065** for domestic students, and **\$18,430** for international students. The Annual Building Fund Levy does not attract a discount.

### ANNUAL BUILDING FUND LEVY – *compulsory*

The Annual Building Fund Levy is a compulsory building improvements and maintenance levy, used for the acquisition, construction and maintenance of school buildings, and to support capital loan repayments. The Annual Building Fund Levy will be proportioned in accordance with the chosen payment terms.

**OVERSEAS STUDENT HEALTH COVER (OSHC) – international students only**

As a requirement of student visas, international students must have health insurance in place for the duration of their visa before arriving in Australia. OSHC fees are determined by the individual provider, and are subject to change.

Students may request IES College arrange OSHC on their behalf. IES College’s chosen OSHC provider is [ALLIANZ Global Assistance](#), who charges approximately **\$1075** for 24 months cover. If students would like to purchase their own OSHC from another provider, they will need to make arrangements directly with the provider and then forward the policy to IES College.

**STUDENT ACCOMMODATION**

IES College has partnered with [Australian Homestay Network](#) and [Student One](#) to provide students with accommodation in the instance that they are under IES College’s guardianship, as either an international student or a domestic boarding student. Accommodation can be booked directly through the IES College website.  
*Only students 17yrs and older may stay at Student One.*

The [AHN Matching Fee](#) is paid to AHN to cover the administrative costs involved in placing a student in a homestay.

### **AIRPORT PICK UP**

Upon landing at Brisbane airport, students arriving from overseas or interstate require an airport pick up and transferring to their accommodation. Students are billed this fee by their chosen provider once initially, and then again any other time they require an airport pick up (e.g. returning from school holidays).

Book directly via the IES College website, with the chosen accommodation provider.
